**MEASURING** – Dogs entered in any class other than the 20”+ or 16”+ Veterans division (i.e., classes in which the dog’s wither height is 20” and under ) and that do not have permanent AKC or NADAC height cards are required to be measured at the time of check-in. Copies of height cards may be presented at the trial or mailed with entry.

## TRIAL SITE INFORMATION

This ASC of Washington.--R.A.T. ASCA trial is again at Argus Ranch. Indoors on dirt. Outside the arena there is ample room for walking dogs on leash and several areas set aside for off leash exercise. There is limited crating space inside the arena. Please limit use of x-pens and chairs so we can accommodate all our exhibitors. Trial equipment may include: rubberized dog walk, A-frame, and teeter, closed tunnel, open tunnel, weave poles, tire jump, non-winged jumps, winged jumps, double jump.

## MOVE-UPS

Move-ups will be allowed day to day. Process will be detailed at the trial.

## AWARDS

First through fourth place ribbons will be awarded for each jump height in all classes and levels. Qualifying rosettes will be awarded for each qualifying run.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

**Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.**

This trial is sanctioned by the Australian Shepherd Club of America (ASCA) with the Australian Shepherd Club of Washington as the sponsor club in partnership with the Rainier Agility Club. Exhibitors through submission of their entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, including the following rules regarding entry.

- All healthy, trained dogs over eighteen (18) months of age are eligible to compete in ASCA agility trials.
- The handlers should always conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike fashion.
- Bitches in heat, lame or blind dogs are ineligible for entry.
- Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, must be excused from the agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the agility trial.
- I (we) further agree that when my dog(s) are left unattended, they will be secured in a crate or x-pen. Owners/handlers whose dogs are tethered or improperly secured will not be allowed on the show grounds.
- No collars, leads, food, toys, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within ten feet of the ring entrance at any time. The only exception to this is leading your dog to the start on lead, and then handing the lead to a steward. All dogs should be on leash when not competing.
- Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA agility program: a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a member not in good standing with ASCA.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- Participation is a privilege afforded by the Host club and may be extended or withdrawn (for suitable causes only) by the Host club's trial committee. Any refusal of entries will be reported to ASCA.
- There will be no refunds in the event that a dog and or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for the dismissal.
- A 100% refund will be given for any request received prior to the closing date. Requests for a refund of entry fees after the closing date, up to the day before the trial, will be honored less any expenses incurred by ASC of Wa or Rainier Agility Team, and will be issued for the following reasons: bitches in heat, dogs injured or ill (with verification from vet on request) or family

emergency. Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$20.00 service charge for bank returned checks.

- The Junior Handler Division is open to any dog that is being handled by a junior handler who is 17 years of age or younger. Dogs entered in the Junior Handlers Division classes will jump 4" lower than their regular jump height but have the option to jump their dogs at standard jump height.
- The Veterans Division is open to any dog age seven (7) or older, or any handler aged 60 or older, or any handler who has a certificate of disability. Dogs entered in the Veterans Division classes will jump 4" lower than their regular jump height.
- Current Jump Height Table, Breed Exemption List, description of classes, levels, and divisions are included in the current ASCA Agility Rules and Regulations Handbook.

### ASCA ENTRY INFORMATION

- All ASCA agility trials are open to purebred and mixed breed dogs.
- Dogs do not have to have an ASCA registration or tracking number to participate in an ASCA agility trial.
- If your dog is an ASCA registered Australian Shepherd, fill in your dog's ASCA registration number where designated on the entry form.
- If your dog is not an ASCA registered Australian Shepherd and you would like to earn ASCA titles, you will need to obtain an ASCA tracking number for your dog. Any dog is eligible to get an ASCA tracking number (not just Australian Shepherds). Once you have an ASCA tracking number, use it as your dog's "ASCA Registration Number" on all entry forms. ASCA Service Membership and Tracking Number Forms are included in this premium. They can also be obtained at ASCA's website ([www.asca.org](http://www.asca.org)) under "Forms".

1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA, and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5 Exhibitor/owner release ASCA, the Australian Shepherd Club of Washington and the Rainier Agility Team (including its officers, directors, and members, and event organizing committee), the site owner of Argus Ranch (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises.
